WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

You'll need to submit your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) for consideration of need-based financial aid, including federal and state grant money that you don't have to pay back. But the FAFSA is going through major changes, including:

- The 2024-2025 FAFSA is not expected to open until Dec. 2023.
- Students need to invite their parent(s) to complete the FAFSA.
- Students and parent(s) must provide consent for the IRS to release 2022 tax information to the Department of Education (DOE).
- The DOE may not send FAFSA data to colleges until late Jan. 2024.

WHAT YOU CAN DO NOW TO PREPARE

- Students and their parent(s)/contributors must each have an individual FSA ID. Visit <https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/> to create or access your account.
- Visit www.mcdaniel.edu/FAFSA for the latest information about applying and our awarding timelines for new and current students.
- Plan to fill out your FAFSA as soon as possible following Jan. 1.
- Be sure to add McDaniel using our school code: **002109**
